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
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# **Intro**

There are now some excellent tools, platforms. apps, and aids for you that you can use online to provide online training.

Integration of technology in education simply refers to the use of technology to enhance the student learning experience. Utilising different types of technology in the classroom, including a virtual classroom. creates learners who are actively engaged with learning objectives. The implementation of technology creates also pathways for differentiated instruction to meet the unique needs of students as individual learners within a broader classroom climate.

In the world we live in is, technology is literally everywhere, and children adapt to it more than anyone else. Unlike teachers, students are being raised in a digital world. For students of all ages, it is natural to use technology in every aspect of their lives. Therefore, digital tools both for virtual learning and in classroom are becoming more and more crucial.

We have selected several innovative digital tools which can be used by educators and students.

#### 1.Effective Lesson Plans

Creating a lesson plan begins with aligning state standards to your curriculum and then narrowing the focus to determine which objectives you want your students to meet within a specific unit of study.

Strong lesson plans are the foundation of an efficient classroom environment for both the teacher and the students. Lesson plans contain several components that can fit into one of three categories:

- What am I teaching?
- How am I going to teach it?
- How will I assess what the students have learned?

#### Design an effective lesson plan

Most lesson plans follow a universal structure for teachers to implement essential learning across curriculum and grade-levels:

- Set goals
- Create an overview
- Manage timelines
- Know your students
- Execution
- Set Goals

Teachers must first determine which state standards will be addressed within a specific unit. Using state and Common Core standards, teachers can then create objectives for each individual lesson based on their unique curriculum and knowledge of their students' capabilities.



#### **Create an Overview**

Having an overarching idea of what you want to teach in a unit plan allows teachers to determine what essential questions will be addressed, which resources will be used throughout the unit, and which vocabulary words or skills need to be front-loaded prior to beginning individual lesson plans within the unit.

#### **Manage Timelines**

Duration is a key feature of lesson planning. Since no two classrooms are identical in terms of how students learn and retain information, it is crucial for a teacher to get to know their students in order to create appropriate timelines. Formative and summative assessments can be implemented to allow a teacher to determine if a lesson objective needs to be retaught or revisited within a unit.

#### **Know Your Students**

The way you structure each lesson relates to how well you know your students and what type of learners they are.

Keeping in mind that educators are working with a tech-savvy generation, lesson plans that integrate technology engage students actively. From using Google Earth in a geography lesson to dialing up YouTube videos of clips of Shakespearean performances, technology can be implemented in the classroom in a variety of ways that make learning a more demonstrative and interactive endeavor. This helps give teachers a genuine depiction of their students' capabilities and begin working towards building a proficient classroom.

When students are learning online, it can be tricky to find meaningful ways to oversee student progress. The good news is that most online software tools allow teachers to track and measure student responses.

Here are three constructive ways to assess and supervise student performance:

Keep the lines of communication open. Unlike traditional school settings
where students can talk with teachers in person, online contact is necessary to
keep kids motivated to hand in assignments on time and stay on track. As well,
holding daily office hours with email, phone and chat capabilities can help
prevent kids from falling behind in their studies.



- Curriculum-based testing. Teachers may find curriculum-based testing is a
  good way to ensure students can apply what they've learned. Frequent
  evaluations help teachers determine where students struggle with lessons and
  make plans for addressing unfinished learning. Formative assessments such
  as quizzes, short evaluations, and conversations with students can help them
  correct mistakes.
- **Set up learning targets.** Learning targets help students to reach specific goals in each lesson. For instance, if a student struggles with subject-verb agreement, teachers may consider breaking down lessons into smaller targets to make it easier for the student to apply proper grammar to their writing.

Online learning is not a one-size-fits-all solution — challenges exist because of technological limitations and access for some students.

### 2 Video Screen Sharing in Real-Time

When it comes to video communications, on a reliable cloud platform, screen sharing apps enables a user to instantly see another user's screen and direct them through the toughest of conversations, guidelines, and interfaces.



#### 1. Zoom



Zoom is a platform that was originally designed for business meetings online and for companies to have an online space for employees. Zoom though has developed into an excellent tool for use as a <u>virtual classroom</u> and their software is now used by:

Universities and schools to create large virtual classrooms for hundreds of students

Businesses to provide <u>staff and employees</u> live online training as eLearning modules or real-time online classes and tuition.

Great for teaching online for both individual freelance trainers, and for both small and large companies. One of the best tools on the market for providing online training.

Zoom is probably the most popular online software in the market for holding meetings, classes and online get-togethers, especially since the start of the pandemic.

Zoom offers the following to their users:

- Chat function to chat with your whole class or individual students
- Breakout rooms to separate students into groups for discussions
- Share screen function to share your screen or allow students to share their screen
- A built-in whiteboard with text and drawing features to share with your students.

The free version allows up to 100 participants, unlimited one-on-one meetings but a limit of only 40 minutes for group meetings.

Zoom is a great option for teachers who need a platform to teach their students since this app is used worldwide and most people are comfortable and familiar with its functions.

#### 2. Skype Video



#### a) For Freelance Trainers and Individuals Teaching Online

<u>Skype video</u> has traditionally been very popular for video calls to family and friends but Skype is also increasingly being used by businesses these days and it is an excellent option if you are looking to provide both teaching and training online. Skype also, by the way, integrates nicely with Microsoft teams (see below).

As an individual offering corporate training online (i.e. if you are self-employed), you can use the personal version of Skype and this is an incredibly easy and cheap way to offer online classes and lessons 1-to-1.

How to share your screen on Skype video

On Skype, you can easily share your screen with the people or person you are chatting with by clicking the overlapping boxes at the bottom of the interface. You will see these boxes when you are in a video call with someone (see image above).

b) For Company Training Online (and Co-working Space Online)

Skype is also excellent for Groups!

In addition to being an excellent option for team meetings and online co-working space, you can use <a href="Skype Groups">Skype Groups</a> for teaching and training employees and staff from afar.

## 4. Facilitate Group work

It is believed that working in a group enables students to develop their group/team working skills which are often essential in the workplace today. Research results indicate that group working can often achieve more than an individual working alone. Research suggests that students work best when they are made up of four or five members. Larger teams become difficult to coordinate while smaller teams usually lack the resources to do a thorough job. As you continue to build your course, keep these questions in mind:

- What benefits can you students get out of group activities?
- What strategies you can use to foster and motivate your students working as groups?

The following tools are ideal to Facilitate Group Work. Online courses allow for multiple ways to complete assignments and for students to interact with each other on course material. In order to best mimic a face-to-face classroom, teachers should provide focused discussions and smallerassignments that go toward completing a group project. While group work looks a bit different in online courses, online learning software provides multiple opportunities for teachers to assign and productively engage students in group work.

Making students accountable to others can facilitate engagement in course materials, which in turn can improve student retention


